Topic: Gifts



Part 1:

Introduction and Interview (4-5 minutes)

Examiner: Good afternoon (Good morning). My name is ----- . Can I have your full name, please?

Answer: My name is ----- .

Examiner: Thank you. May I see your passport (identification), please?

Answer: Sure (Of course). Here you are.

Examiner: In the first part of the interview, I'm going to ask questions about yourself. (Examiner asks questions about work, studies, hobbies, future plans, sports, etc.) = 2-3 minutes

Examiner: Let's talk about gifts.

1. *How often do you buy gifts for people?*
2. *Do you try to buy expensive gifts?*
3. *What are the most popular gifts in your country?*
4. *Why do people give gifts?*

Examiner : That's the end of Part 1. Now we're moving on to Part 2.

Part 2:

Task Card (3-4 minutes)

Examiner: Now we are going to start Part 2. For this Part 2, I'm going to give you a card with a few questions about a specific topic. You'll have one minute to prepare your talk and you can make notes. I'll tell you when the time is up, and you can speak for 1 or 2 minutes and I'll tell you when to stop speaking after 2 minutes. Okay?

Here is the card. Your one minute begins now.

Describe an event from your time at school

You should say:

How old you were

What the event was

Who was there

And say why you still remember this event

Examiner: OK, your preparation is up. You have 1 or 2 minutes to speak. Let's begin.

Part 3:

Questions Connected to Part 2

(4-5 minutes)

Examiner: Now we're going to discuss school days.

1. *Why do some students like to participate in school events?* [Ideas question]
2. *Which is better, watching a school event or participating in it?* [Opinion question]
3. *What are the advantages of schools having big events? What are some disadvantages or risks?* [Ideas question]
4. *Should school events be optional or mandatory for students?* [Opinion question]
5. *What skills can students learn by participating in school events?* [Ideas question]
6. *How often should schools hold events?* [Opinion question]

Examiner: Thank you for your answers. We have now reached the end of the speaking test.
