### Topic: Dreams



## Part 1:

### Introduction and Interview (4-5 minutes)

Examiner: Good afternoon (Good morning). My name is ----- . Can I have your full name, please?

Answer: My name is ----- .

Examiner: Thank you. May I see your passport (identification), please?

Answer: Sure (Of course). Here you are.

Examiner: In the first part of the interview, I'm going to ask questions about yourself. (Examiner asks questions about work, studies, hobbies, future plans, sports, etc.) = 2-3 minutes

Examiner: I would like to ask you a few questions about dreams.

1. *Do you dream much at night?*
2. *Do you usually remember your dreams?*
3. *Do you think dreams can come true?*
4. *Do people in your country talk a lot about dreams? [Ideas question]*

Examiner : That's the end of Part 1.

## Part 2:

### Task Card (3-4 minutes)

Examiner: Now we are going to start Part 2. For this Part 2, I'm going to give you a card with a few questions about a specific topic. You'll have one minute to prepare your talk and you can make notes. I'll tell you when the time is up, and you can speak for 1 or 2 minutes and I'll tell you when to stop speaking after 2 minutes. Okay?

Here is the card. Your one minute begins now.

2. *What can we learn from dreams?* [Ideas question]
3. *Can dreams affect our health?* [Opinions question]
4. *Can dreams make people do things?* [Opinions question]
5. *Do you think that science can explain dreams?* [Opinions question]
6. *Whom should people talk to about their dreams?* [Opinion question]
