

You can also add -er to adjectives.

“-er” means “more.” (If you use “adjective + -er, you have to use “than,” too.)

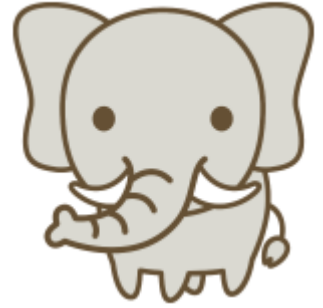
