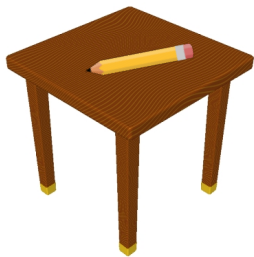
Points!

Where is my pencil? - It's on the desk.



Where do you live? - I live in Yokohama.



Is the cat under the table? - No, it's next to the window.

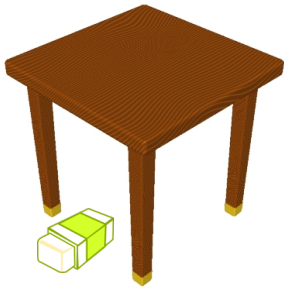
