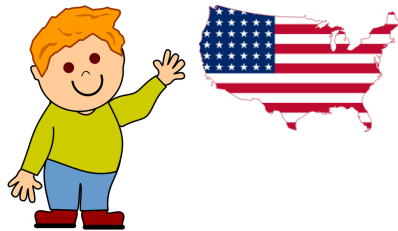

Interrogative sentences using Be-verbs and their responses

Are you American?

Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.



Are you a volleyball fan?

Yes, I am. / No, I'm not. I'm not a volleyball fan.



What are you doing?

I'm reading a book.



一般動詞の疑問文

Interrogative sentences using Verbs and their responses

Do you eat sushi?

Yes, I do. / No, I don't. I don't like sushi.



Does Amy play the guitar?

Yes, she does. / No, she doesn't.



Did you have breakfast?

Yes, I did. / No, I didn't.



What did you eat at lunch?

I had noodles.



Where does Tom live?

He lives in New York.



Which do you want, coffee or tea?

I want tea.

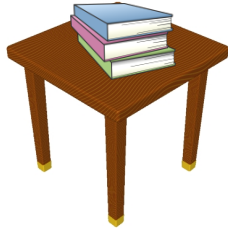

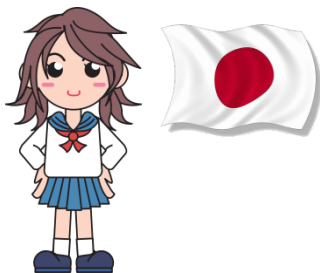

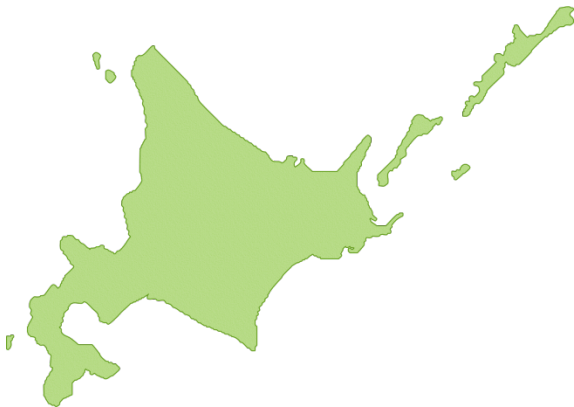
